Primarily, the Film Team Resident will collaborate with the Film Team.

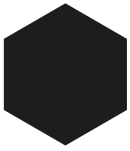
Essential Responsibilities

- Support the Film Team in ensuring all film content matches the mission and branding of The Austin Stone through collaboration with the Film Team Director and Design Director

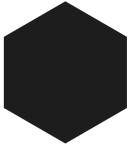
