### Summary

The For the Nations (FTN) Team's mission is to see church planting movements amongst 100 unreached people groups. Advocacy Teams, sending short-term trips to ministry partners (long-term workers), supporting goers while they are stateside, and the day-to-day administrative and organizational support are components of that mission.

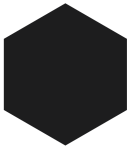
As part of the For the Nations Ministry at The Austin Stone Community Church, the Global Missions Resident will be responsible for providing administrative, communication, system support and training for Advocacy Teams, short-term trips, and For the Nations programs and operations.

The Global Missions Resident will report to the For the Nations Director.

### Essential Responsibilities

Residents are not required to be proficient in any of the following, but rather exhibit a desire to be coached and grown:

- Develop and support written communication for the ministry, including, but not limited to, magazine content, newsletters, emails, social media content, promotions, website updates, and more
- Promote opportunities for congregational engagement in the ministry
- Provide event planning and execution support
- Provide project management support, including, but not limited to, creative and/or graphic design, email templates, content development, social media, etc.

- Supporting the Short-Term Trips Manager in the planning and execution of short-term trips (including finances, travel, housing, etc.)
  - Opportunities to shepherd and guide people toward discernment of short-term trip participation
  - Help recruit, train, deploy, and support Advocacy Teams, Mission of God class, and short-term trip volunteers

- Work in the office Monday through Friday
- Weekly staff and supervisor meetings
- Attend all required events and activities for The Austin Stone and For the Nations Ministry, including staff meetings, prayer meetings, special events, retreats and staff development days

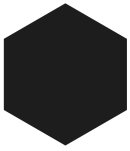
### **Austin Stone Culture**
